The presenter of this show needs to be an engaging host and a strong interviewer with great ideas, contacts and storytelling skills.

- Present Music 101 with a consistently high standard of accuracy, authority, fluency and flair.
- Identify, select, refine and collaborate on music news stories, interviews and programming, presented in a knowledgeable and entertaining style, creating an engaging live radio experience for our target audience.
- Close the loop: utilise radio, digital and social media tools to engage with our audiences
- Represent RNZ at industry events, festivals, awards etc.
- Work collaboratively with colleagues across RNZ on a range of projects and stories to deliver quality content.
- Use third-party distribution platforms as agreed with Music/Digital editorial teams.

- Maintain RNZ’s high standards in terms of quality, impartiality, independence, accuracy and editorial standards and style, media law and broadcast standards.
- Actively seek professional and personal development opportunities.
- Keep up to date with technological and industry developments.
- Ability to handle breaking news events within the live Music 101 show if they occur.

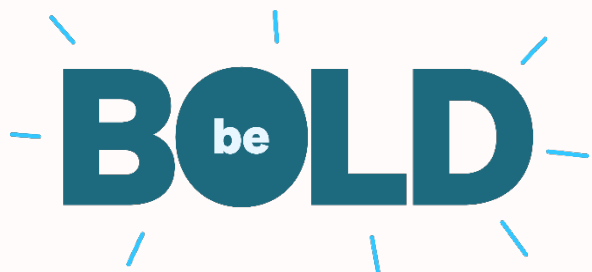
