Te Tūranga - About the Role

The Test Lead role is responsible for leading the delivery of testing services that support the design, development and maintenance of RNZ's audience-facing digital applications, and the services that enable them.

This role sits within the Product & Development team, and works closely with developers, designers, support and project team members to ensure the quality and reliability of some of RNZ's most critical digital products.

Alongside practical testing, the Test Lead will develop test plans and approaches, influence product workflows, gather and document testable requirements, and determine the Definition of Done and Acceptance Criteria for team tasks.

This role plays a key part in delivering exceptional digital experiences for RNZ's audience by ensuring content and functionality is delivered seamlessly, across platforms and devices.

Te Mahi - About the job

- Test Lead tasks, including:
 - Leading and delivering functional testing activities throughout the Software Development Life-Cycle (SDLC)
 - Providing guidance on best practice methods and approaches to testing for software design and development
 - Collaborating with the Product & Development team on:
 - Data management
 - Test automation delivery
 - Test environment management and performance
 - Other non-functional testing activities
 - Working with business users and designers to gather and document testable requirements
 - Establishing clearly defined Definition of Done and Acceptance Criteria for tasks
 - Leading or supporting the implementation of test processes
 - Working with others in the Product & Development Team, contractors and service delivery partners to plan and deliver testing activities that advance the strategy of the team and the broader organisation — across projects and BAU activities
 - Working across RNZ's different platforms and applications — including legacy systems — to modernise, maintain or replace them
 - Estimating test effort across diverse system architectures, both functional and non-functional.
- Service delivery, including:
 - Proactively identifying opportunities for improvements to existing testing processes and practices (and wider team workflows) to propose and help implement changes
 - Sharing knowledge and providing support to other team members
 - Developing and maintaining relationships with individuals and teams across RNZ, and with contractors and service delivery partners.
- Project support, including:
 - Participating in project- and task-level planning and delivery activities, including scoping, workflow management, review and release
 - Influencing the improvement of project approaches and activities over time
 - Working with designers, users and other stakeholders to understand requirements, and present back development progress — where relevant.
- Participate in and contribute to the development and achievement of personal performance targets; undertake personal training and development, to maintain and enhance skills; and support peers to develop their skills and experiences.

Note: Our existing legacy products use a range of languages (Ruby, Go, JavaScript and PHP) and frameworks (Rails, Stimulus, React and WordPress), to varying degrees, with some in very limited instances. This role will help rationalise, standardise and reduce the number of languages and frameworks over time.
